Some tips:

- Provide well-written, quality answers on your actual Candidate Form. If you do not use complete sentences or proper grammar, or fail to show the ability to compose an intellectual paragraph, your Candidate Form may not be reviewed. For example, do not write abbreviated words or use slang; do not answer in simply one sentence, or simply put N/A.
- Use plenty of details and examples to allow us to learn as much about you as possible.
- Leadership and service skills can be anything from babysitting, tutoring, helping the community, working with a church group, volunteering with family, and anything you do with Ascend or your previous school.
- Use the last section to tell us anything else you feel makes you a great candidate (accomplishments, awards, goals, achievements)

Expectations for NHS Members

- Maintaining a GPA of 3.75 or greater.
- Participating in one NHS group service project in the spring semester. Preparation will occur throughout the semester, but the main time commitment will be 1-4pm April 15.
- Documentation of at least 10 hours of individual service hours during the spring semester
